



Memphis-Area Joint Engineers Council Annual Engineers Week Student Contest

As part of its Engineers Week Activities in February, the Memphis-Area Joint Engineers Council sponsors a contest for Middle School (Grades 6, 7, 8 & 9) and High School (Grades 9, 10, 11, & 12) students in the Greater Memphis Metropolitan Community. It is an opportunity for students to express their creativity and demonstrate their ingenuity by working on concept projects designed to improve our quality of life.

CONTEST OBJECTIVES:

Present a product that could be used to benefit society. This could involve:

Inventing something

Modifying something to make it more useful or better

Finding another use for something that normally would be discarded.

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS:

A school may submit as many teams (projects) as it wants where a team may consist of 1 to 4 students. Each team will make a two-minute presentation to the judges (local professionals from all branches of engineering). Projects may be demonstrated by use of models, actual devices, drawings, sketches, a poster or any combination of the above. Each team will be provided with a table approximately 3ft by 3ft. to set up their display. Electricity will be available. Judging Criteria include:

Benefit to Society

Creativity

Feasibility

Presentation
